U.S. HOCKEY HALL OF FAME GAME COVID-19 TESTING EVENTS IN NASHVILLE
COVID-19 RAPID TESTING AVAILABLE IN NASHVILLE OCTOBER 29-30

GRAND FORKS, ND, October 20, 2021 – Those attending the U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame Game will have two COVID-19 testing opportunities in Nashville. Testing meets Bridgestone Arena’s criteria for entry into the Saturday, October 30, 2021 game. Those fully vaccinated do not need to show proof of a negative test, but will need to show proof of vaccination.

Nashville testing will be available as follows:

- Where: Cambria Downtown Nashville (hotel), 118 8th Avenue South, Nashville, TN 37203
- Friday, October 29 from 8:30am – 5:30pm
- Saturday, October 30 from 8:30am – 2pm

Nashville testing event notes:

- Entry Doors: Front entrance of the hotel on street level, then proceed to the elevator in order to go up to the hotel lobby on the 5th floor
- Testing Room Located Inside Cambria Hotel: Rickenbacker Room on 5th Floor of Cambria Downtown Nashville. The Rickenbacker Room is located near the Front Desk on the 5th floor of the hotel.
- Cost: \$50 per test
 - Payments must be conducted with credit or debit card. No cash accepted.
- Test provider: Recover Health
- Type of test available: Rapid antigen
- Health Insurance Required: No
- Paperwork Required: Yes, filled out on-site
- Mask Protocols: Masks are required to be worn inside testing location

If available, fans located outside of Grand Forks are encouraged to test in their own communities beginning Wednesday, October, 27. Follow Ralph Engelstad Arena social media and visit theralph.com/Nashville for event updates and information.
