How does it work?

During the 2021-2022 season, any current ND/MN college student that works on a part-time basis at the Ralph Engelstad Arena complex (Ralph or Betty) is eligible to qualify for an end of semester bonus in each of the Fall and Spring semesters equal to \$2 per hour for every hour worked at REA during the semester - in addition to all of the other discounts, benefits, and compensation provided. The College Assistance Program is an additional bonus!

Is there a limit to the amount you could earn in the College Assistance Program?

Absolutely not. The more you work, the larger your bonus will be at the end of the semester.

Who is eligible?

Any part-time employee at REA who is also a current full-time college student attending a local college in ND or MN is eligible to participate in this program. This opportunity is available to both new and returning REA employees.
