



Ticket and Event Information Announced for 2022 U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame Game in Las Vegas

GRAND FORKS, N.D. - JANUARY 19, 2022 – The countdown is on for the 2022 U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame Game in Las Vegas. This destination event returns to Las Vegas inside the 17,000+ seat T-Mobile Arena, pairing North Dakota and Arizona State for a college hockey showdown on Saturday, October 29, 2022.

Tickets for the game go on sale to the general public starting Saturday, February 12. An exclusive pre-sale opportunity will be available for North Dakota Champions Club members beginning Monday, February 7. The Champions Club pre-sale will be a sequenced process based on priority point rankings. Champions Club members will receive an email that includes pre-sale ticket purchasing instructions, including an electronic link to the exclusive Champions Club pre-sale approximately 48 hours prior to the start of each presale window. Tickets for this game are digital and are purchased through the AXS ticketing platform. It is recommended that fans set up an AXS account before purchasing tickets. Ticket prices for the 2022 U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame Game are \$250, \$150, \$125, and \$80, plus ticketing fees.

- Official Pregame Party – Located on Toshiba Plaza outside of T-Mobile Arena on Saturday afternoon, October 29. The Pregame Party features two acres of entertainment for fans and a great place to gather as they get ready for the big game. This event is free and does not require a ticket.
